

NTCIR is a series of evaluation workshops for Information Access Technologies like Information Retrieval (IR), Question Answering (QA), Summarization, Text Mining, Machine Translation, etc. and providing research infrastructure for evaluation and testing, and forum of researchers. It has placed emphasis on processing of East Asian languages, but attracted international participation.

NTCIR-9 has hosted the following four core tasks and three pilot tasks under a new organization structure. Most tasks are new in NTCIR-9 and we had one of the largest number of participated teams in the history of NTCIR! [Core Tasks]

- GeoTime: Geo Temporal Retrieval
- INTENT: mining and satisfying different user intents for a query, + 1CLICK subtask: satisfying a user's need by the first output
- **RITE:** Recognizing Inference in Text
- SpokenDoc: Retrieval for Spoken Documents
- [Pilot Tasks]
 - CrossLink: Cross-Lingual Link Discovery
 - VisEx: Interactive Visual Exploratory
 - PatentMT: Translation of Patent Document
