On behalf of National Institute of Informatics, I would like to express our gratitude for the efforts and the collaboration of those who participated in the fourth NII Test Collection for Information Retrieval (NTCIR-4) Workshop.

This volume is the formal record of research activities of NTCIR-4 meeting, 2-4 June, 2004, in which the final reports on the participants' research activities since January 2003 were presented.
