1. Sentences for learning phonemic pronunciation
 - 1) 460 Phonetically-balanced sentences
 - 2) 32 Sentences including phoneme sequences difficult for Japanese to pronounce correctly.
 - 3) 100 Sentences designed for test set
 - 4) 302 minimal-pair words
 - 5) 300 phonemically balanced words
2. Sentences for learning prosody of speech
 - 1) 94 sentences with various intonation patterns
 - 2) 120 sentences with various Accent Patterns
 - 3) 109 words with various accent patterns

Speakers

202 speakers (100 males and 102 females)

Each sentence in the set is read by 12 speakers and each word in the set is read by 20 speakers.
